CSU Online MBA and MCIS ProgramsRanked #1 in Colorado

The US News and World Report ranked CSU's online master's in Business Administration (MBA) program #1 in the state of Colorado for the fifth year in a row. Nationally, the MBA was ranked #52, which placed it within the top 15% of the programs included in the ranking. CSU's online master's in Computer Information Systems (MCIS) was ranked #31 in the country and placed within the Top 20 programs for veterans nationwide. The MCIS was also rated the best in the state for the
